

**Fee Schedule:**

**Application for practising certificate and the Solicitor's Guarantee Fund contribution**

**Standard Fee**

The standard application fee for the grant of a local practising certificate is \$1,000.

An applicant for the grant of a local practising certificate is entitled to a discount if:

- (a) the application is made on or after 01 January but before the 30 June; and
- (b) the applicant either –
  - (i) was not an Australian legal practitioner on the previous 30 June; or
  - (ii) was a local legal practitioner on the previous 30 June but was not required by s 42(6) of the Act to renew his or her local practising certificate.

The discount is 50% of the Standard Application Fee.

The following table applies to the renewal of your current Western Australian practising certificate.

<b>01 May to 31 May</b> Complete application submitted during the standard renewal period	\$1,000
<b>01 June to 30 June</b> Complete application submitted during the late fee period is subject to a fee of 25 % of the standard application fee in addition to the standard application fee.	\$1,250
<b>01 July to 31 July</b> Complete application submitted during the overdue period is subject to a fee of 50 % of the standard application fee in addition to the standard application fee.	\$1,500
<b>After 31 July</b> Complete application submitted after the overdue period is subject to a fee of 100 % of the standard application fee in addition to the standard application fee.	\$2,000

**Solicitors' Guarantee Fund**

Practitioners who have been practising in Western Australia for more than 2 years but less than 7 years are required by legislation to pay a yearly fee of \$20 in addition to the application for a practising certificate fee. This is the Solicitors' Guarantee Fund contribution.
