



Application to licence an overseas vehicle

Road Traffic Act, Section 31

- Note:
- To be eligible for a free licence, applicant must be a resident of the country which issued the current licence and must not be a permanent resident of any Australian state or territory.
 - Applicant must produce a *carnet* or *triptyque* or such other documentary evidence establishing that the owner has given to the customs Department of the Commonwealth government a guarantee that the vehicle is to be subsequently taken out of Australia and evidence of the vehicle being currently licensed overseas.
 - Vehicle must be inspected prior to the grant of a Western Australian vehicle licence.
 - The licence of an overseas vehicle becomes invalid if the owner (who is not a permanent resident of Australia):
 - becomes a permanent resident of Australia; or
 - transfers the vehicle licence to a permanent resident of Australia.
 - A 3rd party licence will be issued only to the expiry of the registration document, Carnet or Triptyque whichever comes first to a maximum of 12 months.
