



## **EXTENDED TRADING PERMIT - RESTAURANT SUPPLY LIQUOR WITHOUT A MEAL (RESTRICTED TO 120 PERSONS OR LESS)**

### *Documentation to be lodged*

- Form 120 - Notice of Application**
- Application fee of \$51**

### **Important considerations**

- It is your responsibility to ensure that the service of liquor without a meal complies with relevant Local Government requirements before making this application.
- 120 persons can be on your premises at any one time. This includes customers, staff and any other person who remains on the premises.
- Liquor without a meal can only be served to persons who are seated at a table and the liquor must only be consumed whilst persons are seated at a table.
- Liquor without a meal can only be served between 6am - 12 midnight Monday to Saturday and 10am - 10pm on Sunday.

*If your restaurant can accommodate more than 120 persons, you can still apply for an extended trading permit using this form, provided you agree to restrict the number of persons who can be on your premises at any one time to 120.*

*If you wish to sell liquor without a meal and do not wish to restrict your numbers to 120, you will need to apply for an extended trading permit using Form 6A. That application will require supporting documentation such as a public interest assessment. *Please note that the application fee for a permit of this nature is not applicable when lodging the permit application at the time of lodgement of an application for the grant of a restaurant licence.*

**DECLARATION**

By applying for an extended trading permit to serve liquor without a meal as a restaurant that holds a maximum of 120 persons, I solemnly declare that the following details are true and correct:

1. The maximum number of persons that can be on my premises at any one time is 120 or less; or
2. Whilst the maximum number of persons that can be on my premises is more than 120, I consent to limit this number to 120 and have my licence conditioned accordingly.

**INFORMATION**

1. The maximum number of persons that can be on the premises (including outdoor areas such as footpaths and alfresco) can be 120 and this includes patrons, staff and any other person who remains on the premises.
2. The licence and permit will be conditioned to state that a maximum of 120 persons can be on the premises at any one time, however if the restaurant only has approval for a lesser number of persons (through Local Government or any other approval) it must operate according to the more restrictive requirement.
3. This application is not required to be accompanied by a certificate from the Local Government Authority to show that the premises complies with local planning laws. However, the licensee is still responsible for ensuring that the service of liquor without a meal complies with any relevant Local Government requirements.
4. The licence and permit will be conditioned to state that liquor can only be consumed by persons who are seated at a table and the supply of liquor restricted to table service by staff of the licensee.
