name, address and date of birth to Dunn and Bradstreet Pty Ltd (Australia) and Lawpoint Pty Ltd to gain public information relating to bankruptcy or corporate involvement.

- 11) I will comply with all requirements, standards and expectations set out in Regulation 8, Schedule 2: Code of Conduct of the *Migration Agents Regulations 1998*.
- 12) I have read and understood that the receipt of notices occurs in accordance with section 332H of the *Migration Act 1958*; and
