This is an **interactive** form and applies to an RSL, club or association who wish to possess and display firearms and ammunition of a kind that was used as a weapon of war, on nominated premises.

If you have never held a firearms licence or permit in NSW, or you do not currently hold an equivalent issued firearms licence or permit interstate, you are required to complete firearm safety training for longarms and/or pistols.

Attach a certificate of successful completion of an approved firearm safety training course for longarms and/or pistols, if applicable.

All applicants are required to provide:

- A completed P634** 'Application for a Firearms Permit' form
- Proof of Identity** (*if no other NSW firearms licence or permit is held or has been held*).
- A Legitimate Reason** form with the relevant sections completed:
 - Description of premises used for RSL
 - Evidence of affiliation with the Returned Services League of Australia (NSW Branch), or a member of the RSL and Services Clubs Association Limited
 - Firearm safety training certificate, *if applicable*
 - Certification from the Secretary that the firearms are (or will be) of a kind used as weapons of war and any prohibited firearms will be rendered permanently inoperable or other firearms will be rendered temporarily inoperable.
 - Information on the safe storage facilities specific to the types of firearms to be kept
 - Details of the arrangements for the security of firearms whilst on display
 - Police inspection Event number
 - Fee \$75 (cheque, money order or credit card authority), with the application**

BUSINESS APPLICANTS ONLY - A completed P635 for each employee to be authorised by this permit AND proof of identity for each employee (*if no other NSW firearms licence or permit is held or has been held*) AND Safety Training Certificate, *if applicable*.
