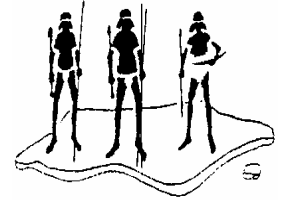

 - (viii) the distance of the proposed excavation and / or stockpiles from adjoining drains, watercourses, roads and future transport corridors (eg. road, rail and public transport as shown on the relevant Planning Scheme and associated documents) footpaths and buildings (where applicable); and
 - (ix) groundwater resources, flows, existing users, etc; and
 - (x) surface water resources, flows, quantities, licensing requirements, existing users etc; and
 - (xi) riparian vegetation; and
 - (xii) provision and maintenance of buffers for the integrity of watercourses; and

A statement signed by the applicant, the owner and the occupier of the land indicating the size, the proposed haulage routes and the description of the vehicle or vehicles to be used, type of product to be carried therein, the maximum weight of any load, the type of covering on the vehicle or other means to be used to prevent dust escaping from the vehicle in such a way as in the opinion of the Council, may cause or be likely to cause, a nuisance; and
3. If blasting is to be carried out as part of the extractive industry operation, an application for – (Blasting Operations); and
4. A copy of any environmental impact statement or similar document prepared as part of the process of obtaining development approval for the proposed extractive industry operations.
