^ Where the dog is declared a Dangerous Dog or a Menacing Dog. If it is Regulated Dog an Application for Restricted Dog Permit must be attached to this application.

+ Working Dog are exempt from registration and microchipping requirements but must meet the criteria under the Animal Management (Cats and Dogs) Act 2008.

The State Government introduced registration for all cats and dogs under the Animal Management (Cats and Dogs) Act 2008. Rockhampton Regional Council is following that requirement from 12 December 2010.

**All cats and dogs must be registered from 12 weeks of age or upon transfer of ownership.**

All cats and dogs must be registered within 14 days of being kept in the Rockhampton Regional area.

Working Dogs are exempt from mandatory registration, however there are strict guidelines for the classification of a working dog under the Act.

**Micro chipping is mandatory for all cats and dogs from 12 weeks of age or upon transfer of ownership.**

Desexing is recommended for all cats and dogs at an appropriate age; check with your local vet.

**Sale, Give Away or Trade of Dogs or Cats**

The original owner of the animal is responsible for the registration of the animal and is required to have the animal micro chipped prior to transfer of ownership. If the animal is under 12 weeks of age, the new owner is responsible once the animal reaches the age.
