Part 4 – Collection of dead marine wood on unallocated state land

Collection of dead marine wood on unallocated State land for trade or commerce is a self-assessable development under Schedule 3 of the *Sustainable Planning Regulation 2009*. Therefore, a resource allocation authority for collection of dead marine wood must be used together with the *Self-assessable code for dead marine wood collection on unallocated state land for trade or commerce* (code number MP01).
