**CONDITIONS ATTACHED TO A BINGO PERMIT**  
GAMING AND WAGERING COMMISSION ACT 1987  
(Section 95)

**THESE CONDITIONS ARE AN ANNEXURE TO A BINGO PERMIT**

1. Each bingo session shall be controlled by the permit holder, or a member of the organisation to which the permit has been issued, nominated by the permit holder. The permit holder or their nominee from the organisation is not permitted to participate in the playing of bingo. The person in control of the session shall determine any disputes.
2. A session of bingo shall not exceed a period -
  - (a) of three hours; or
  - (b) thirty two (32) gameswhichever is the shorter.
3. No charge shall be made for admission to any bingo session other than for the cost of cards.
4.
  - (a) The price of a card shall not be more than 30 cents
  - (b) The price of a Flyer Sheet shall not exceed \$3.00.
- 5a The total of all prizes paid for each session of bingo shall be calculated on the bingo gross receipts for the session in accordance with the following table;

Gross Receipts	Total of Prizes (Gross Proceeds)
\$3,000 and under	Up to 100%
\$3,001 and over	55% - 65%

- 5b Goods may be given as prizes subject to:
  - the aggregate value of the prize goods for the game is not to exceed \$1,000;
  - a player who is awarded prize goods must be offered money to the value of the goods as an alternative prize and may choose to take the money or the prize; and
  - where there is more than one winner in relation to a prize that consists of, or includes goods, and it is not possible to share the goods equally among all winners, then money to the value of the goods must be shared equally among all the winners in that game.
6. Unless prior approval is obtained from the Gaming and Wagering Commission in writing, expenses shall not exceed 20% of the gross receipts. [For the purpose of this condition receipts from bingo, and from any lottery/raffle conducted under section 103 (other than a standard lottery and a trade promotion lottery) and any continuing lottery (hand held break open tickets) are included in the calculation of gross receipts.]
7. All cards used in any one game of bingo shall bear the same serial number and that number shall be announced by the caller, to all players immediately before the commencement of each game.
8. Immediately prior to the commencement of each game the caller shall announce the value of the prize to be awarded for that game.
9. No prize may consist of or include cosmetic surgical and medical procedures.



10. No prize shall be awarded to any player, unless all the relevant numbers in respect of the prize to be awarded, on the face of the card held by such player, have been properly called.
11. The prize or prizes for each game shall be paid as soon as is reasonably possible after the conclusion of the game to which the prize or prizes relate. In the event of more than one winner in any one game, the prize money must be shared equally between such winners.
12. **A Jackpot prize can be offered from EITHER receipts from that session of bingo, or from other funds. The prize cannot be offered from a combination of other funds and receipts from that session of bingo.**

A jackpot prize may be offered up to a maximum value of \$3,000. If a jackpot is provided from funds other than receipts from that session of bingo it shall not be included in the total of prizes for that session, or in the total value of incentives, or in the calculation of expenses. If the funds are provided from the **receipts** of the session they should be included.

13. The permit holder shall keep, or cause to be kept, an accurate record of the bingo gross receipts, the amount of prizes awarded, and obtain and keep for a period of twelve (12) months receipts or other proof of payment made for all expenses relating to the conduct of each session of bingo.
14. No other game of chance shall be conducted, or permitted to be conducted, on the same premises used for the conduct of any session of bingo, other than a continuing lottery, a lottery deemed to be permitted under section 103, a standard lottery and a trade promotion lottery.
15. A minimum of two "spotters", who shall not be permitted to play, shall be provided where a session has more than 100 players.
16. At the conclusion of each game of bingo, winning card(s) numbers shall be called back and shall be checked with the drawn numbers by two unsuccessful players in such game. The unsuccessful players shall not be the same people for each call back of numbers.
17. The permit holder shall within 7 days of the end of each month furnish a financial return in accordance with the regulations together with the 1% surcharge to the Gaming and Wagering Commission.
18. The permit holder shall keep copies of all "Bingo Financial Returns" for a period of twelve (12) months.
19. No person shall prior to any session of bingo announce, or cause to be announced, advertise, or cause to be advertised the value of any prize, projected value, estimated value or potential value of a prize at that session.
20. These conditions shall be displayed in the following locations on the premises:
  - a) in close proximity to the caller.
  - b) in close proximity to the players.
  - c) in close proximity to the entrance of the premises.
21. The permit shall be displayed in a prominent location on the premises.
22. The permit holder shall furnish the Gaming and Wagering Commission with all such information (including copies of documents) relating to the subject of the permit including but not limited to information relating to the disbursement of moneys (particularly the purpose or purposes to which they were applied) constituting the gross receipts from the gaming or lottery the subject of the permit as the Gaming and Wagering Commission may from time to time require.

## **SCHEDULE 4 – RULES FOR THE CONDUCT OF PERMITTED GAMES**

### **PART 1 - PERMITTED BINGO**

- 1. Children Excluded**  
Children under 12 years of age not permitted to play bingo.
- 2. Spotters Excluded**  
Where a session has more than 100 participants, a minimum of two (2) “spotters” must be provided who shall not be permitted to play bingo.
- 3. Checking Players**  
An unsuccessful player may only take part in the call back of a game once in each session.
- 4. Bingo Cards**
  - (a) Every bingo card must have 15 numbers printed on it;
  - (b) All cards used in any one game must bear the same serial number and that number must be announced to players immediately before the commencement of each game.
- 6. Playing of Split Games Permitted**
  - (a) A split game involving a specified pattern or range of numbers may be played during a game of bingo;
  - (b) Where a split game is to be played during a game of bingo the permit holder must cause the type of split game or games that are to be played to be announced before the commencement of the game;
  - (c) Where no split game is to be played during a game of bingo the permit holder will cause this to be announced before the commencement of the game;
  - (d) Interim prizes will be awarded to players winning split games in accordance with rule 5A(2)(a).
- 5A Award of Prizes**
  - (1) For the purposes of this rule a number is properly called when the person calling the number has announced both the number displayed to him or her and any colloquial expression for that number (eg. for number 22 - "two little ducks, twenty-two").
  - (2) A prize for a winning split or a full house will not be awarded to a player unless:
    - (a) in the case of a player calling a winning split, the last number properly called forms part of the winning split; and
    - (b) in the case of a player calling a full house, the last number properly called is on the player's card.
- 5B Conclusion of a Game of Bingo**
  - (1) A game of bingo concludes when a player is awarded a prize for obtaining a full house.
  - (2) Where:
    - (a) a split game is being played during a game of bingo; and
    - (b) a player obtains a full house before any player obtains a winning split.

The player obtaining the full house will receive any unclaimed prize in respect of the split game in addition to the prize awarded for the full house.

**6. Prohibitions**

Except where the gaming permit authorises it:

- (a) the price of a card:
  - (i) where the card is a separate "flyer" card shall not exceed 50 cents; or
  - (ii) shall not exceed 30 cents;
- (b) there shall be no more than 2 games using "flyer" cards per session;
- (c) there may be one game in which both a standard prize and a prize contingent on the number of calls made prior to a winning card being announced ("snowball" prize) may be offered, and the "snowball" prize shall:
  - (i) if not won, be offered in the next session without increasing in value; and
  - (ii) be included in the calculation of the value of the total prizes paid for each session at which it is offered.

**7. Jackpot Prizes**

A jackpot prize can be offered from **EITHER** receipts from that session of bingo, or from other funds. The prize cannot be offered from a combination of **other** funds and **receipts** from that session of bingo.

A jackpot prize may be offered up to a maximum value of \$3,000. If the jackpot is provided from funds other than the receipts from that session of bingo it shall not be included in the total of prizes for that session, or the total value of incentives, or the calculation of expenses. If the funds **are** provided from the receipts of the session they should be included.

**8. Prizes to be Announced**

The permit holder will cause the value of the prizes for each game to be announced before the commencement of the game.

**9. Prize Shared If More than One Winner**

- (1) Where there is more than one winning card the prize money will be shared equally among all the winners.
- (2) Where:
  - (i) there is more than one winning card in relation to a prize that consists of, or includes something else having a value other than money ("prize goods"); and
  - (ii) it is not possible or practicable to share the prize goods equally among all the winners; money to the value of the prize goods will be shared equally among all the winners in place of the prize goods.

**10 Prizes Paid as Soon as Practicable**

Prizes awarded for each game of bingo will be paid as soon as practicable after the conclusion of that game.

**11. Player Who Makes Incorrect Call Allowed To Continue Play**

A player who incorrectly calls a winning split or a full house in a game is allowed to continue to play in that game.

**12. Late Calls by Players Permitted**

A call by a player indicating a winning split or full house in a game will be accepted if it is made by the player at any time prior to the conclusion of the calling back of the numbers for that split game or game (as the case may be).

**13. Time When a Call by a Player Made**

A call by a player indicating a winning split or full house is not a valid call unless the call is acknowledged by the person calling the numbers or by a spotter.

## HOW TO COMPLETE A BINGO FINANCIAL RETURN

This is a guide to completing your bingo financial return. If you have any difficulties please telephone (08) 9425 1888 to speak with a Gaming Inspector.

### ITEMS

- 1 Refers to the total number of books you have for sale in that bingo game.
- 2 (a) Refers to the number of bingo books you sold in that bingo game.  
(b) Refers to any books sold in the second half of the bingo game. (Many Organisations do not have half time sales). (If you do not sell books at half time leave this space blank).
- 3 (a) Refers to the number of books given away to people for no charge. (Free books should only be given to the people who volunteer their time to help with the bingo night).  
(b) Refers to damaged books. This also refers to any books that are left over from a series that has been sold out. Often there are some books left over and it is easier to make them un-saleable rather than carry them over from week to week.
- 4 Refers to the books left over after subtracting the totals of Items 2(a), 2(b), 3(a), and 3(b) from the figure shown at Item 1.
- 5 Refers to the total amount of money raised by the sale of books at the game.
- 6 Refers to the amount of money raised by the sale of "flyer sheets".
- 7 Refers to the amount of money raised from the sale of bingo books and "flyers". (Add Items 5 and 6 together to give you the total bingo proceeds.)
- 8 Refers to the surcharge (1%) that is payable to the Gaming and Wagering Commission. This is calculated as a percentage of the figure shown at Item 7. If the amount shown at Item 7 is \$150.00 and the surcharge payable is 1% the amount shown at Item 8 would be \$1.50.
- 9 (a) Refers to the monetary total of the bingo prizes (full house and splits) paid out for that bingo session including "flyer" prize.  
(b) Refers to the monetary value of any jackpot prize offered from the receipts for **that session of bingo**. (If the jackpot prize is offered from funds other than the receipts from that session of bingo it should not be included here- it should be included at point 14).  
**TOTAL = (Total of 9(a) + 9 (b))**  
(c) **Jackpot Carry-Over** Refers to the total accumulated jackpot contributions carried forward from previous bingo sessions. If there is no carry-over please write „Nil“.  
**JACKPOT PRIZE: Please Note: A Jackpot prize can be offered from EITHER receipts from that session of bingo, or from other funds. The prize cannot be offered from a combination of other funds and receipts from that session of bingo.**  
On the day the Jackpot is paid out the amount must be equal to the Jackpot Carry-Over of the previous sessions (9)(c)) plus the contribution towards the Jackpot of the day (9)(b)) the payout should not exceed \$3 000 dollars. If at any time the maximum of \$3 000 dollars for the Jackpot is reached no further contribution toward the Jackpot can be made until it is won.
- 10 Gross Bingo Profit (Item 7 minus the total of item 8 + item 9)
- 11 **Less Other Expenses**  
Refers to expenses incurred at (a) (b) (c) (d) (e) (f) (Total of item 11 = (a) (b) (c) (d) (e) (f))
- 12 Net Bingo Profit Item 10 minus the **total** at item (11).
- 13 Total Gross Proceeds = (a) + (b) + (c)
