**To successfully submit an application for a Petroleum Infrastructure Licence, the application must be made in the approved manner, which includes completion of this form, must be accompanied by the prescribed fee, and also include submission of detailed attachments providing the following information:-**

An application for an infrastructure licence should be accompanied by the following information (appropriate elements of which may be submitted by applicants for an associated production licence):

- a) A plan drawn to an appropriate scale showing:
  - i) The outline of the proposed infrastructure licence area.
  - ii) A locality plan (A4 size) showing a centroid for the area in relation to the field from where the hydrocarbons are being sourced, relative title boundaries and other adjacent infrastructure.
- b) **Digital mapping data** is to be provided as an ESRI ArcGIS shapefile or Mapinfo tabfile together with associated files. The coordinate datum is to be GAD94 and in a deprojected (latitude/longitude) format. Preferably, data should be emailed to: petroleum.mapping@dmp.wa.gov.au quoting the survey name or alternatively submitted on disc with the application.
- c) Full facility description, including:
  - i) Field Name(s), Project Name and Title Number.
  - ii) Location of the proposed facility (i.e. within the title or other location).
  - iii) Facility purpose (i.e. processing petroleum, converting petroleum, partial processing, storing or preparing for transport).
  - iv) A development schedule, including detailed plans of facilities proposed to be constructed.
  - v) Precise licence area, including total area in square metres.
  - vi) Detailed Safety Zone application, if required.
- d) A summary of any environmental surveys.
- e) Draft safety and environment management plans.
- f) If the current title is a Retention Lease or Exploration Permit, provide details of your Production Licence Application or enclose herewith.
- g) Infrastructure Development Plan and Field Development Plan (if applicable).
- h) Information on how the combined production and infrastructure operations will not interfere with other users of the sea to a greater extent than necessary, including details of third party interest affected and any arrangements or negotiations entered into with those third parties.
- i) Proposed technical and commercial arrangements with any closely associated production licences and pipelines (either granted or anticipated).
- j) Evidence of the applicant's technical and financial capacity to construct and operate the proposed facility(ies), including:
  - i) Technical qualifications of the applicant and its key employees.
  - ii) Technical advice available to the applicant.
  - iii) Evidence of the applicant's ability to fund the project.
- k) The prescribed fee, stated in the Schedule of Fees, is to be made **payable to the Department of Mines and Petroleum** through an Australian Bank or by Australian bank cheque and must be submitted with the application. Fees are non-refundable and subject to variation (including Consumer Price Index adjustments) and the current Schedule of Fees must be consulted prior to payment.
- l) Statement of any other matters that the Applicant wishes the Minister to consider.
- m) Where additional information is required to be entered on the form, (eg Company Names, etc) please use an Appendix and submit online with this form.

## SUBMISSION OF APPLICATION

Application, together with supporting data and the prescribed fee (as described above), should be submitted online through the Petroleum and Geothermal Register (PGR).
