Use this form to apply as an individual for a Property Certificate of Registration. This lets you work as an assistant agent in Real Estate, Strata Management, or Stock and Station.

A Certificate of Registration is issued for 4 years and is non-renewable. If you have held a certificate in the last 12 months you may not be eligible to apply again, please refer to the NSW Fair Trading website.

Complete the <u>Add or Remove a Category Application</u> to add a category to an existing Certificate of Registration.

Am I eligible?

You must be 16 years or older and have completed the required qualification/s.

How much does a certificate cost?

Information about the current fees is available on the <u>NSW Fair Trading</u> website. Fees are GST exempt and include a non-refundable processing component.

What happens next?

Your application and supporting documents will be assessed to ensure you meet the requirements to hold a Certificate of Registration. We will endeavour to complete the assessment of your application within our service standards, however, please note that if we need to contact you for additional information this may increase the time we take to assess your application.

How will I know the outcome of my application?

We will let you know whether your application is granted or refused by email. If your application is refused, we will contact you in writing outlining the reason/s and provide you with details of your options.

Privacy Collection Notice

NSW Fair Trading, Department of Customer Service gives priority to protecting the privacy of your personal information and health information. We do this by handling your personal and health information in a responsible manner and in accordance with the *Privacy and Personal Information Protection Act 1998* (PPIP Act) and *Health Records and Information Privacy Act* (HRIP Act).

Service NSW acts as a shopfront for NSW Fair Trading in relation to your property licence or certificate. Service NSW will collect and use the personal information you provide to verify your identity and confirm your current contact details. Service NSW will share the information it collects with NSW Fair Trading in order to process and receive your application.

The personal and health information contained in your application is collected and held by NSW Fair Trading for the following purposes:

- 1. To process an application for an individual for a Property Certificate of Registration in accordance with the *Property and Stock Agents Act 2002* and section 12 of *Licensing and Registration (Uniform Procedures) Act 2002* No 28.
- 2. Internal administrative purposes, including liaising with you in relation to your application, creating or maintaining records in your MyService NSW Account and/or Service NSW Business Profile, and verifying your identity documents.
- 3. We may use the information to support more informed policy making, program management, evaluation, research and service planning as it can facilitate more efficient service delivery for residents and business in NSW.
- 4. As required by legislation to record information on a public register, parts of which will be published online.

You are legally required to provide personal information if you want to apply for, update or renew a licence. If you do not provide this information to us, we may not be able to process your application.

We note as part of the application process, if you have selected yes to being a "mentally incapacitated person", you may be asked to provide medical evidence from a medical practitioner. This will help us decide whether you are eligible for a licence or certificate under the *Property and Stock Agents Act 2002*.

We may use the personal information and health information contained in your application to confirm your details if you make any subsequent applications in relation to any licence or authority issued by NSW Fair Trading. We may also use it to administer/update our customer database, including to send you information that we consider important such as reminders to renew licences.

We will store and manage your personal and health information in accordance with provisions under the PPIP Act and HRIP Act. This being the information is to be kept for no longer than necessary for the purposes of which the information may lawfully be used. The information is disposed of securely, protected by taking reasonably necessary safeguards against any loss, unauthorised access, use, misuse, modification or disclosure against all other misuse of the information.

If required, we may make enquiries and exchange information with other NSW government agencies (including the NSW Police Force), or other States, Territories and/or the Commonwealth for the purpose of assessing your application and for compliance purposes. We may disclose your personal information for these purposes.

We will not use or disclose your personal information and health information to anybody else unless you have given consent, or we are authorised or permitted to do so by law. <u>Our Privacy Statement</u> describes when this may occur.
